Scott McGregor has been involved in the media for over 30 years as an actor, presenter, writer and producer and over the last decade has extended his many interests into the world of travel. Inspired by his experiences hosting tours for the Powerhouse Museum and others he decided to establish Railway Adventures in 2012. Since then he has led more than 40 tours to almost 40 countries. Graduating from NIDA in 1979, he appeared in a wide range of stage, film and TV roles including the lead role in the ABC's epic mini-series *1915* and the *Coral Island*. He has presented and hosted numerous prime-time ratings winners including many years as the handyman on *Better Homes and Gardens* and the host of *Room For Improvement*. He presented two series of his own *Railway Adventures* for Channels 10 and 7 and a number of programs for The History Channel. He also owns and operates RUWENZORI which he built in the 1980's from vintage railway carriages on top of the Great Dividing Range near Mudgee in central NSW. TOUR MAP



Day 1 • Friday 16 April: SYDNEY - COOTAMUNDRA

Your tour begins with a welcome briefing at Central Station prior to boarding our privately chartered train complete with lounge, dining and bar cars, departing around 9:00am. We head south along the Illawarra line hugging the scenic escarpment to Wollongong. Our train branches off at Unanderra to begin the steep climb up the range to the Southern Highlands. This spectacular run offers sweeping views up and down the South Coast as the train battles to get up the razorback. Passing through Robertson we join the Main Southern Line at Moss Vale and then continue to Goulburn where we pause before we progress down the line. Lunch is served in the dining cars along the way after which you can enjoy the afternoon reclining in the lounge or sitting cars. We pull into Cootamundra in the afternoon and transfer to your motel for some down time before re-grouping for a welcome dinner at a local restaurant.

Overnight: Cootamundra Heritage Motel, Cootamundra (or similar), (L, D)

Day 2 • Saturday 17 April: COOTAMUNDRA - TEMORA - PARKES

After breakfast we board our train for the journey west through the junction of Stockinbingal to Temora. Here we transfer to the Temora Aviation Museum, home to one of the largest collections of vintage aircraft in the country, many of which are in working order. Your day at the 'Showcase' will include fly pasts of a variety of rare and iconic warbirds and operational historic flying machines. You have time at the air showcase to explore the excellent museum and have lunch either at the show or in town. We will have our coaches on hand to take you on a shuttle to the CBD and the Rural Museum which has a great collection of historic artefacts.

We re-board our train in the mid afternoon and progress back to Stockinbingal Junction where we shunt our train onto the 'Inland Rail' line and begin our trek north to Parkes arriving in the late afternoon. This evening we have dinner with entertainment at the Parkes Services Club.

Overnight: Parkview Motel or North Parkes Motel, Parkes (B, D)

Day 3 • Sunday 18 April: PARKES - BATHURST

After breakfast at the motel we head down to the railway station to board our train for the journey along the western line through Manildra and Orange stopping at the heritage village of Milthorpe for time to graze and browse in the excellent array of shops, galleries and cafes in this charming place.

Back on the train we'll have an early lunch and upon arrival in Bathurst we'll wander across to the newly opened Bathurst Railway Museum to learn of the impact of the railway on the culture of the city and marvel at the extraordinary working model of the western line on show. You then have the option to explore more of Bathurst and its world class Fossil, Mineral and Motor museums. You may also wish to take a tour out to the spectacular Mayfield Gardens, one of the country's most extensive private high-country gardens in the English style.

This evening you will be hosted to a grand dinner in the old ballroom of Abercrombie House.

Overnight: Rydges, Bathurst (B, L, D)

Day 4 • Monday 19 April: BATHURST - SYDNEY

This morning is at leisure before we pack up and head down to the railway station for our run back to Sydney. Lunch will be served along the way and our arrival is expected in the mid-afternoon, completing a great escape on the Wings and Wheels adventure. (B, L)
